

BSE Investor Training Program: Navigating the Securities Market: A Path to Smart Investment Organised by the Institution's Innovation Council under the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) from 2nd July 2024 to 5th July 2024

International Management Institute, Kolkata has conducted Investment Awareness Programs (IAPs) of SEBI, along with the Investors Protection Fund of the BSE (BSE-IPF) in collaboration with Institution's Innovation Council and Internal Quality Assurance Cell. Being a Securities Market Trainer of SEBI, Dr. Dona Ghosh was the resource person for the programs that were conducted on 2nd, 4th and 5th July 2024. The program's objective was to raise financial awareness among young investors about the Indian Security Market. The programs covered the following topics: the structure of the Indian capital market; risks and returns of different financial instruments; how to make financial planning; due diligence of investments and grievances redressal. A total of 183 people (62.3% male and 37.7% females), including students, faculty members and staff members of the institute, participated in the Investment Awareness Programs.
