Today's ceremony reflects a proud moment for IMI Kolkata. As a vibrant business school, within just 5 years it has crafted a special place for itself in the academic map of the country. Recently IMI Kolkata has been ranked 12th among Indian management institutes. It has also been rated 3rd among private business schools by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. IMI Kolkata has also been awarded the status of a "Rising Star" among Indian business schools by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India. The two-year full time PGDM programme of our institute is now NBA accredited, it has also been accorded equivalence with the Master of Business Administration (MBA) Degree by Association of Indian Universities (AIU), effective July 2016 for a period of two years.

IMI Delhi, in its early days courageously faced the challenges of India's pre-liberalization phase. The Late Dr. R.P Goenka in 1981 took the initiative to form a society, called the International Management Society. In 1981 IMI was established as India's first corporate-sponsored business school, with its campus in New Delhi which was built in collaboration with the then IMI, Geneva, Switzerland to provide skills-based education.

Three decades later, in 2010, Dr. Rama Prasad Goenka and his son Sanjiv Goenka pioneered IMI Kolkata and Bhubaneswar. The development of IMI Kolkata reflected their strong emotional connect with the city which had been the knowledge capital of the country for many years

supported by a rich history of culture, art, education and intellect. We are feeling happy that IMI Kolkata has been able to live up to the Founders' dream of nurturing excellence in its own right.

We are proud that IMI Kolkata today is equipped with the best of faculty, structure and systems to support its mission to teach and train socially sensitive and globally competitive corporate citizens. The Institute's progress in engraving its name in the international space of business education has already earned global recognition. IMI Kolkata has active research and academic collaborations with ten renowned universities or institutes across the world. It has also built a promising faculty and student exchange programme. International conferences are often organized in collaboration with overseas academic institutes.
