



COOPERATION AGREEMENT

The Instituto Internacional de Educação – IIE (Brazil) and IMI (India), have between them, set this term cooperation under the following terms and conditions:

CLAUSE ONE - OBJECTIVES OF THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT

1.1. This Cooperation Agreement is to establish a program of technical cooperation in the educational and scientific field.

1.2. General Objectives of the Agreement:

A. Contribute to the scientific and technical development of the participants involved through the execution of joint projects that:

- Expand the availability of knowledge and human resources with better technical-scientific input;
- Implement and develop institutional capacity for research, scientific and technological updating;
- Establish a program of cooperation that will contribute to the development of projects undertaken jointly by the following ways:
- Exchange of information and personnel of higher technical level or international level;
- Training for researchers, teachers, students and technicians on the premises of these institutions;
- Attending to requests relating to the implementation of the analysis and testing, in the laboratories of these institutions;
- Participation of the faculty or research institutions in these programs, courses, seminars or conferences, or projects;
- Technical/scientific events that are held;
- Use of physical infrastructure, equipment and personnel, by consensus and amendment to this instrument.

B. These activities will be implemented within the institutional objectives of the Parties, encouragement of university or institutional functions of teaching, research and extension.

CLAUSE TWO – PROCEDURES

2.1. In accordance with the objectives of this Cooperation Agreement, the activities planned will be defined and characterized through agreements or agreements between the *Amendment* herein stated parties, in compliance with rules and conditions to which they are subjected.

2.2. Knowledge co-produced during the work, as well as results from experiments and/or surveys, may be used by the agreeing parties for publication as well as in their teaching and research. Restrictions on publication will be set out explicitly in their contracts or specific Addenda.

CLAUSE THREE- NATURE OF BUSINESS

3.1. These activities could have the characteristics:

- * Extension projects, research and development (usually seeking general information/preliminary and short/medium term);
- * Technical consultancy carried out by professionals to be determined by with agreements;
- * Internship programs for researchers and students from faculties of physical education, physical therapy, marketing, administration, psychology and pedagogy;
- * Presentation, organization or seminars, lecture series and/or courses;
- * Technical support services to extension, research and development.
- * Use of human and physical structure of the agreeing parties, regardless of the service recovery, and decoding that previously established by the parties.
- * The physical structure will be established in the case of the agreement, the representative of the Arrangement.
- * Identification of state of the art in matters of interest with agreements including access to international programs, such as Masters degrees and PGDMs from partner institutions.

3.2. Each party must ensure each other all the facilities and elements needed to fully monitor the activities to be developed within this Statement of Cooperation Agreements establish what or Addenda.

CLAUSE FOUR - COORDINATION OF WORK

4.1. Each activity defined in the agreements or Addendum will be led by a Coordinator and one of THE PARTIES OF THE ARRANGEMENT.

4.2. Coordinators of the work responsible for:

- * Set of proposals for development activities until the drafting of agreements;
- * Promote the exchange of information through meetings and progress reports;
- * Follow the schedule of technical activities related to the Agreement Addendum.

CLAUSE FIVE - THE AGREEMENTS OR TERMS SPECIFIC ADDITIVES TO THE TERM OF COOPERATION

5.1. Agreements and Addenda to this Cooperation Agreement, beyond the description of the planned activities, but not being limited contain when necessary, the following items:

- * Objective of the work;

* Indication of the work Coordinator or Coordinators, as appropriate, responsible for oversight and management of this work.

* Human resources, material and financial resources involved;

* Dates and deadlines for implementing the relevant steps of the work;

* Distribution to participants of the responsibilities for procurement of various resources, including funding, as well as requirements for the implementation of the work;

* Other minor they may be necessary for the perfect execution of the work described in the Agreement or Addendum signed by legal representatives of each participant.

5.2. Modifications to the Agreement or the Addendum may be proposed at any time. These changes will take effect only when made in writing and signed after the new Agreement or Addendum.

CLAUSE SIX - MONITORING OF TERM OF TECHNICAL COOPERATION AND COMMUNICATION

6.1. The overall monitoring of this Statement of Cooperation will be conducted with agreements of the following representatives.

6.2. All communications will be primarily done in writing or by email.

CLAUSE SEVEN - TERM OF AGREEMENT ON TECHNICAL COOPERATION


7.1. The duration of this Cooperation Agreement is of indefinite duration, starting from the date of signature.

7.2. This Cooperation Agreement may, however, be rescinded by either party upon written notice by the other party for not less than 80 (eighty) days, subject to the effects of actions taken and all addenda.

7.3. If there are works in progress or being started, the completion of each of these works has to be completed unless a mutual agreement is reached.
